

OAKLAND CITY COUNCIL
JANUARY 26, 2009
SPECIAL SESSION

The Special Session of the Oakland City Council met at Oakland City Hall and was called to order by Mayor Tim White at 5:00P.M. Council Members present were Gleaves, Moniz, Wede and Newberg. Motion by Wede, second by Gleaves to approve the agenda. 4 Ayes, motion carried.

Motion by Gleaves to open public hearing for the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program. Wede second. 4 Ayes, motion carried. No public was present for discussion and no written comments were received. The City of Oakland intends to submit a Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) application to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for the acquisition of properties located within the floodplain. Eligible properties must be located within the City of Oakland floodplain and must have had damage from flooding events. A copy of records from these damages (insurance claims, National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) claims, etc.) will be necessary for the application. Participation in the application does not commit property owners to selling their properties. Project scope is regulated by a positive Benefit Cost Analysis which is a requirement of the HMGP application. The Council discussed that there would be some cleanup at the property at 108 Freeman of old tires and junk. Motion by Moniz, second by Gleaves to close public hearing. Motion by Gleaves, second by Wede to submit HMGP Application. 4 Ayes, motion carried.

Motion by Wede, second by Gleaves to adjourn. 4 Ayes, motion carried.
