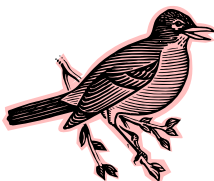

OTHER GARBAGE and CLEAN UP CONCERNS

Garbage: Every resident is allowed 6—32 gallon cans per week. Garbage and must be put out prior to 7 a.m. *Larger cans* will not be picked up.

Yard Waste: can be disposed of at the *City Compost pile* located 1/4 mile west of town on G42. This is **only for grass clippings.**

Rubber Gloves, Diapers, Body Wipes, Cleaning Clothes or wipes, etc.



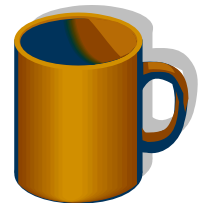

PET NEWS:

PET LICENCES

All owners of Cat(s) and Dog(s) over the age of six (6) months must procure a dog or cat license from the Clerk *on or before July 1st, each year.*

Fees: \$3.00 for spayed or neutered.
\$15.00 for non-spayed or neutered.

Proof of Rabies is required before a license can be issued.

ANIMAL NUSIANCES

City Ordinance 55.06 “At Large Prohibited. It is unlawful for any owner to allow a dog to run at large within the corporate limits of the City.”

City Ordinance 55.08 “Annoyance or disturbance. It is unlawful for the owner of a dog to allow or permit such dog to cause serious annoyance or disturbance to any person or persons by frequent and habitual howling, yelping, barking, or otherwise; or, by running after or chasing person, bicycles, automobiles or other vehicles.”

Impound Costs: Impound costs are twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) plus the food and care charged by the veterinarian.

Please note proof of rabies and proof of license must be given before animal can be released.
