PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

The City of Oakland will be holding a Public Hearing to review an application for a State Revolving Fund (SRF) loan and to make available to the public the contents of an environmental information document and the City's project plan. These documents include design and environmental information related to the proposed improvements to the City's water distribution system.

The proposed project includes replacing older cast iron mains and installing new 6", 8", 10", and 12" water main throughout the town in the right of way, new water meters and water meter pits, and new copper service lines. Abandoned water mains may be cut and capped. The project includes all necessary connections and appurtenances, including gate valves and hydrant assemblies.

The purpose of this Public Hearing is to inform area residents of the community of Oakland of this proposed action, discuss the actual cost and user fees associated with this project, and to address citizen's concerns, if any, with the plan.
