## OAKLAND CITY COUNCIL JANUARY 10, 2024 REGULAR SESSION

The Regular Session of the Oakland City Council met in the Oakland City Services Building and was called to order by Mayor Brant Miller at 7:00p.m. Pledge of Allegiance was said. Council Members present were Applegate, Bernard, Moniz, Perkins, and Reed. City staff present were City Administrator/Clerk Marissa Lockwood, Public Works Director Kris Bramman and Assistant City Clerk Bre Chappell. Public present were Darin Ford, Dean Schechinger, Kevin and Tera Schechinger, J.R. Becker, Shelby Adams and Ashley Hansen. Motion by Moniz, second by Perkins to approve the agenda. 5 ayes, motion carried.

Open forum was held. No public comments.

Motion by Bernard to approve the consent agenda including December Clerk Report, January Claims, December Library Report, Golf Course Report, Sheriff's Report, minutes from December 11<sup>th</sup> regular session and December 11<sup>th</sup> special session, fire department minutes, Resolution 2024-01-01 "2024 Holiday Schedule", Resolution 2024-01-02 "Designating Official Legal Newspapers" and liquor license renewals for Oakland-Riverside Golf Course, Dollar General #6040 and Oakland Volunteer Fireman's Association. Second by Perkins. Roll call. 5 ayes, motion carried

Kevin, Tera and Dean Schechinger with Impact Hill presented the idea of a collaboration with the city and possibly the school district to build and operate an indoor swimming pool facility at Impact Hill. Lockwood will check with the city attorney to determine the legality of the public/private collaboration before having any further discussions.

Discussion was held concerning the Golf Course Board request to increase from five to six board members. Council decided to leave the board at five voting members, as set up by the city attorney.

Motion by Applegate to approve Wastewater System Improvements – Lagoons monthly progress monitoring report from January 3, 2024. Second by Moniz. 5 ayes, motion carried. Motion by Reed, second by Perkins to approve pay application 4 from Hendrickson Transportation in the amount of \$52,046.68. 5 ayes, motion carried.

Bid was reviewed for purchasing a new pickup. Motion by Reed, second by Applegate to purchase a new pickup from Keast Auto in the amount of \$50,700. 5 ayes, motion carried.

Motion by Moniz, second by Bernard to approve Resolution 204-01-03 "Lot Split – 413 S. Chautauqua Avenue". Roll call. 3 ayes, Reed and Perkins abstained due to conflict of interest. Motion carried.

Miller gave the Mayor's Report. Made committee assignments for 2024-2026 as follows: Personnel and Finance- Bernard/Perkins, Streets-Reed/Moniz, Parks and Pool- Moniz/Applegate, Water, Sewer and Sanitation-Perkins/Reed, Public Safety-Applegate/Perkins, Mayor Pro Tem- Bernard
