## OAKLAND CITY COUNCIL MAY 8, 2023 REGULAR SESSION

The Regular Session of the Oakland City Council met in the Oakland City Services Building and was called to order by Mayor Brant Miller at 7:00p.m. Pledge of Allegiance was said. Council Members present were Applegate, Bernard, Moniz, Perkins and Reed. City staff present were City Administrator/Clerk Marissa Lockwood and Public Works Director Kris Bramman. Public present were Jake Duggar, Maguire Water and Rob Jongquist, Viking Industrial Painting. Motion by Moniz, second by Bernard to approve the agenda. 5 ayes, motion carried.

Open forum was held. No public comments were made.

Motion by Bernard to approve the consent agenda including April Clerk Report, May Claims, April Library Report, Golf Course Report, Sheriff's Report, minutes from April 10<sup>th</sup> regular session, and liquor license renewal for Ruback's. Second by Applegate. Roll call. 5 ayes, motion carried.

Public hearing concerning fiscal year 2023 budget amendment was opened at 7:02p.m. No public comments were received. Hearing closed at 7:03p.m. Motion by Perkins, second by Applegate to approve Resolution 2023-05-01 "Budget Amendment Fiscal Year 2023". Roll call. 5 ayes, motion carried.

Jake Duggar, with Maguire Water gave a presentation on water tower maintenance contract proposal. Rob Jongquist, of Viking Industrial Painting gave their presentation on water tower maintenance contract proposal. Motion by Bernard, second by Reed to approve Viking Industrial Painting's proposal that recommended only overcoating the south tower instead of sandblasting it. 5 ayes, motion carried.

Motion by Perkins, second by Applegate to approve Resolution 2023-05-02 "Approving Construction Contract and Bond" for the wastewater lagoon project. Roll call. 5 ayes, motion carried.

Reed moved to approve Resolution 2023-05-03 "Setting Employee Wages" to hire lifeguards and concession stand workers for the swimming pool. Lifeguards hired are Davis Bramman, Jayden Carrigan, Emma Gordon, Ellyanna Henderson, Aubrey Lopez, Paxtyn Meek, Emma Miller, Monica Osborn, Keaton Rieken, Kyler Rieken, Abe Schechinger, Dalton Schechinger, Cayla Schuester and Sophie Warwick. They will start at \$10 per hour with a \$.25 increase per year returning. Concession stand workers are Samuel Bernard, Kingston Carrigan, Bradyn Comstock, Ryan Conover, Krobin Henderson, Emry Honkomp and Ethan Vlcek and will be paid \$7.25 per hour. Second by Perkins. Motion carried. Roll call. 4 ayes, Bernard abstained due to conflict of interest. Pool fees were discussed and it was decided to leave them the same until the cost of needed repairs is determined.

First reading of Ordinance 66 – An Ordinance amending the code of Ordinances of the City of Oakland, Iowa, 2018 by amending Chapter 47 Park Regulations was held. This changes camping fees to \$15 per night. Motion by Reed, second by Perking to waive the second and third readings of Ordinance 66. Motion by Bernard, second by Applegate to approve Ordinance 66. 5 ayes, motion carried.

Water Conservation Policy was discussed. No change was made to the restriction level at this time. Options for additional source water were discussed, Lockwood and Bramman will contact Regional Water and engineers to discuss options.

Motion by Bernard, second by Perkins to approve Resolution 2023-05-04 "Setting Employee Wages" to increase David Rose Jr's salary by \$1.00 per hour due to obtaining Wastewater grade II certification to \$62,210.20. Roll call. 5 ayes, motion carried.

Bramman gave the Crew Report. Working on pot hole patching, street maintenance project is complete, performing maintenance on wells and began working on getting the swimming pool ready.

Lockwood gave the Clerk's Report. Assistant Clerk Williamson received a scholarship to attend Municipal Professionals Institute in July.

Miller gave the Mayor's Report. Motion by Moniz, second by Bernard to adjourn. Motion carried. Adjournment 10:01p.m.
