PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

The City of Oakland will be holding a Public Hearing to review an application for a State Revolving Fund (SRF) loan and to make available to the public the contents of an environmental information document and the City's project plan. These documents include design and environmental information related to the proposed improvements to the City's drinking water system.

The proposed project will include the construction of up to five new wells (#12-#16), as well as a new electrical building, generator, a valve vault, access roads, and new water main from the new wells to the existing water treatment facility. Various alterations to utilities and piping will be part of this project.

The purpose of this Public Hearing is to inform area residents of the community of this proposed action, discuss the actual cost and user fees associated with this project, and to address citizen's concerns, if any, with the plan.
