

ORDINANCE NO. 66

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND, IOWA, 2018, BY AMENDING CHAPTER 47 PARK REGULATIONS

BE IT ENACTED by the City council of the City of Oakland, Iowa:

SECTION 1. SECTION MODIFIED. Chapter 47, Section 06 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Oakland, Iowa, 2018, is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

47.06 CAMPING. No person shall camp in any portion of a park except in portions prescribed or designated by the Council, and the City may refuse camping privileges or rescind any and all camping privileges. Camping will be prohibited at Schueman Park and The Lion’s Park. Camping will be allowed at Chautauqua Recreational Park in designated area only. Camping Fees are \$15.00 per day and shall be paid in designated drop box. Camping is limited to a two-week stay.

SECTION 2. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
